#### Index by Standards

It has been my experience in working with teachers that nearly all know the standards to teach. Most carry around a grade level or subject area list of standards constantly! They make reference to the standards almost as often as they open their plan books. Some are required to write the standards on the board each day; nearly all write them in their lesson plans.

One problem for me in writing a book for teachers working in many different states throughout the United States and in other locations throughout the world is that the standards aren't standardized! I cannot choose one set of standards and apply them to every grade level in every location. For that reason, I have indexed the activities by subject area, assuming that most of the activities in a particular unit would apply to standards in a given subject.

However, the activities in this book are integrated across the curriculum. Many of them are interdisciplinary. Most require reading, writing, gathering information, organizing and/or research skills. Therefore, many of the activities that I have categorized in one category may address the standards in other areas as well.
